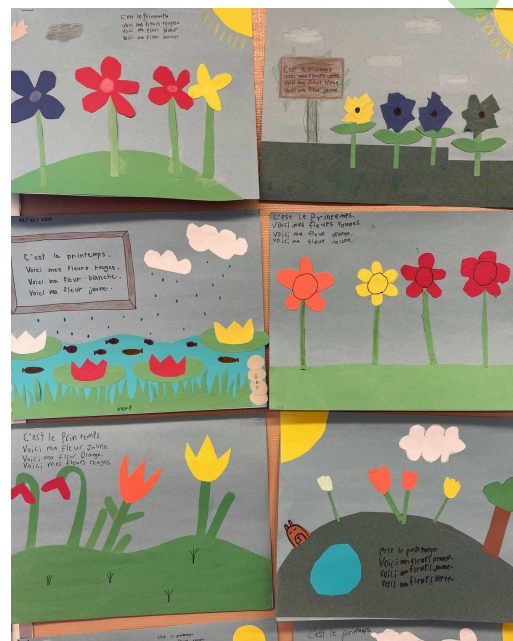

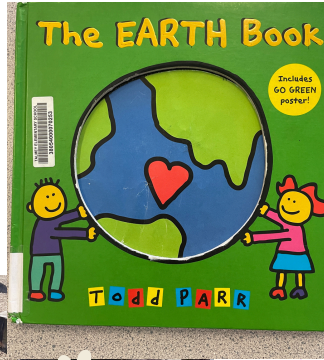

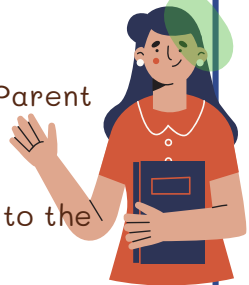
Term 2 learning updates (report cards) will be posted to the MyEd Parent Portal next Tuesday, April 29th.

MODULAR UPDATE



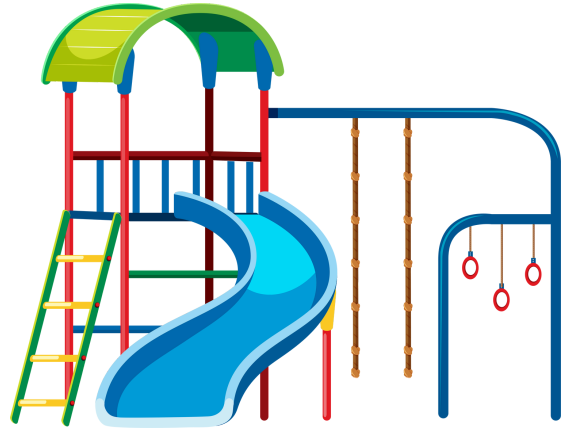
It's been a very exciting week as our modular classrooms were delivered!

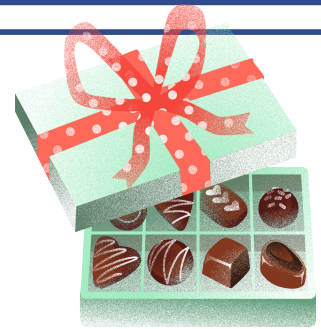

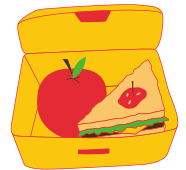


CALL FOR PARENT VOLUNTEERS
