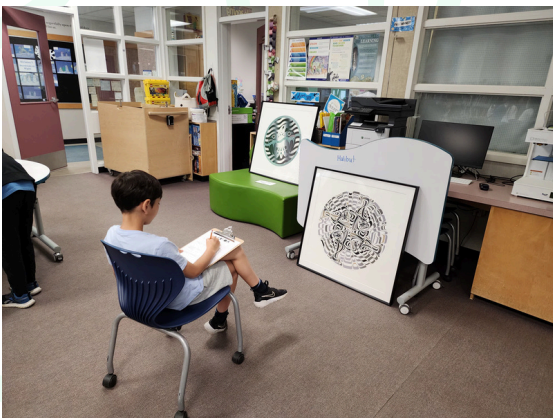




# LEARNING HIGHLIGHTS

## SALISH WEAVE GALLERY WALK (IN OUR LIBRARY LEARNING COMMONS)

This week, our students had the special opportunity to explore authentic artwork from the Salish Weave collection right here at Talmey. They enjoyed walking through the gallery of serigraph prints, gifted by Coast Salish artists to the Richmond School District. Students learned about key shapes in Coast Salish art and connected them to Indigenous stories, math, and science through the life cycles of butterflies, frogs, and other local animals. This activity helped foster a deeper respect for Indigenous culture and the natural world, which is one small step towards reconciliation.

**We are thinking about next year. In May, we invite parents to let us know any special information about their children that will help us to determine the best class placement for next year. Please read the information below:**

### CLASS ORGANIZATION AND STUDENT PLACEMENT 2025-2026

In June, Talmey Staff spends considerable time discussing possible classroom placements for students for the next school year. Although we do not finalize classes until the first week in September, we do some preliminary thinking in June. There are many factors that are important considerations in these discussions:

#### A. Student considerations such as:

- Learning styles and strengths
- degree of independence in work habits
- social and personal characteristics
- previous year's placement
- parent knowledge of their child
- when they have been the youngest or the oldest in a combined classroom. Please note: Over their 8 years in elementary, a student should experience a variety of settings.



#### B. Parent Input

If you have information based on the factors listed above that you would like us to consider when placing your child in a class for next year, please take this opportunity to submit this information to Ms. Hazon ([talmey@sd38.bc.ca](mailto:talmey@sd38.bc.ca)) in writing by **Friday, May 30 at 4:00 PM**.

Information will be reviewed during class placement meetings. **It will not be possible to consider information or requests submitted by parents in September once classes have been established.** Please **do not request specific teachers** – at this time we do not know which teachers will be teaching certain grades next year.

**Please note: We do our best to form the best learning environment for all students.**

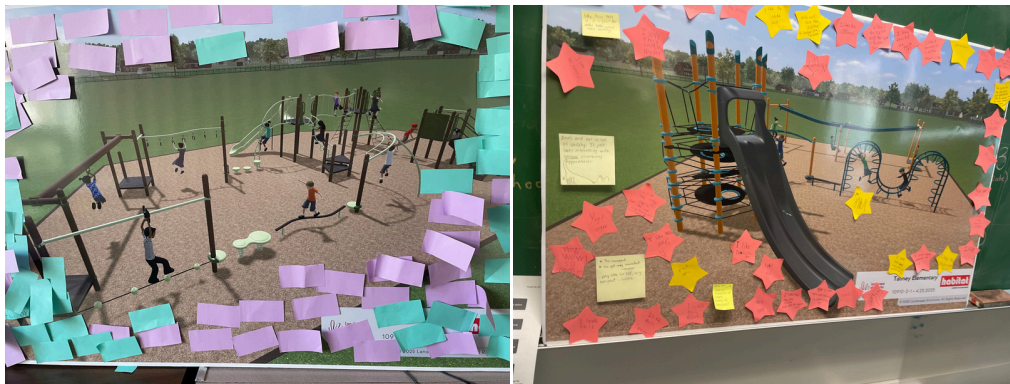


## MARATHON RUN CLUB

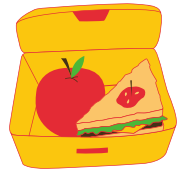
