We wish our class of 2025 the very best of luck as they look ahead to high school in September.






CITY OF RICHMOND ACTIVE PASS

The \$29 Summer Active Pass (<https://www.richmond.ca/parks-recreation/about/sports/summerpass.htm>) will be available for purchasing on Tuesday, June 10th. This low cost, unlimited pass is for 5 to 18 year olds to participate in select drop-in activities including:

- . Swimming, fitness centre access and select drop-in group fitness classes at Minoru Centre for Active Living and Watermania
- . Swimming at South Arm and Steveston Outdoor Pools
- . Skating* at Richmond Ice Centre (public skating only)
- . Golf** at West Richmond Pitch & Putt (Monday to Thursday, 12-4 p.m., excluding holidays)
- . Fitness centre access and select drop-in group fitness classes at Cambie, City Centre, Hamilton, South Arm, Steveston, Thompson and West Richmond Community Centres
- . Select drop-in activities at community centres
