Dear Parents/Guardians,


Our first Universal Hot Lunch will be offered (no cost) on Tuesday, March 10th.



FEBRUARY IS BLACK HISTORY MONTH! RECOGNIZING BLACK HISTORY: FEB 1-28



Every February, Canadians are invited to participate in Black History Month festivities and events that honour the legacy of Black Canadians, past and present.

The commemoration of Black History Month dates back to 1926, when Harvard-educated African American historian Carter G. Woodson proposed setting aside a time devoted to honour the accomplishments of African Americans and to heighten awareness of Black history in the United States.

This led to the establishment of Negro History Week in 1926. Celebrations of Black history began in Canada also shortly thereafter. During the early 1970s, the week became known as Black History Week. It was expanded into Black History Month in 1976.

Our LLC (Library Learning Commons) has a selection of black history books. Below is part of our collection. These books are a series of biographies about aviators, artists politicians, pop stars, athletes, and activists.


STUDENT LEARNING SURVEY- PARENT FEEDBACK

How to opt in:


1. Watch for a text from SchoolMessenger (Text #: 978338).

REMINDERS

EXTENDED ABSENCES

DAY OFF

During the year students may be absent from school for an extended period of time. It is district policy that students may only be absent for 4 (four) consecutive weeks and retain their place in the school. After 4 weeks, students will be removed from the school register. Upon returning, students will have to re-register at the school board office.

If we have space, your child will be placed in a class, but not necessarily the class they left. It will take a few days for your child to be placed, so they cannot begin school on the day you return. If Talmey is full, the district will find space in the nearest available school. Teachers do not provide work for students on extended absences.

HOW TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF GERMS IN SCHOOLS AS RECOMMENDED BY VANCOUVER COASTALHEALTH

Follow guidance on when to stay home from school

Children with fever, cough or a runny nose, diarrhea, or vomiting should stay home until they are well enough to participate in regular activities. If your child has diarrhea or vomiting, they can return to school when they no longer have any symptoms.
